Section C-5B Conclave April 23rd-25th, 2010 Camp Naish

This packet is intended to provide you with all of the information that you will need to get your lodge's contingent registered for conclave. Enclosed you will find the following forms: *Dietary Needs Request*, *Contingent Registration*, and *Housing Needs*.

Location- This year's Section conclave will be held at Camp Naish near Bonner Springs, KS. We will be utilizing the camps Cub World for most of our conclave. The address at Camp Naish is below.

Theme- The theme for conclave is "Sparks from the Past Ignite the Fire of Tomorrow" The Council of Chiefs felt this was a fitting theme for this year for numerous reasons including the 100th Anniversary of Scouting and the fact that we are a newly formed Section.

Camping- Each participant will be responsible for providing their own tents. We will be camping by lodge so your contingent members can coordinate accordingly. If any member of your contingent will have special housing needs please complete the *Housing Needs* form and send it in with your registration.

Registration Fee- The fee for this year's conclave is \$35 until April 9th, 2010. After April 9th the fee will increase to \$40. The registration fee will include this year's conclave patch as well as all activities throughout the conclave.

Trading Post- There will be a Section trading post available at this event. Lodges are also encouraged to bring a selection of lodge trading post items to be sold. The Section will keep track of sales by lodge and all profits from lodge merchandise will be returned to the respective lodges. There will be a variety of OA and BSA items available.

Meals- The Section will provide three meals and a cracker barrel on Saturday and breakfast on Sunday. If any contingent members have special dietary requests, they will need to fill out the *Dietary Needs Request* form. It is important we get these requests as soon as possible so we are able to make arrangements with the caterer.

Physical Forms- Each delegate will need to provide two copies of their physical form. One will be turned in at check-in and the other should be kept by the contingent leader. A minimum of a class II physical is required for this event. All participant medications need to be brought in their original container and kept secure. If any medications require refrigeration, please bring this to our attention at check in.

Tour Permit- Each lodge is responsible for obtaining and abiding by a tour permit from their respective councils.

Participant Guide Book- Upon arrival at conclave each participant will receive a guide book that will contain the conclave schedule as well as detailed information about each activity.

Conclave Activities- Conclave includes a variety of events and activities ranging from Native American activities and trainings, lodge competitions, ceremonies competitions, trainings, and various other activities.

Native American Activities- We will offer training in various aspects of Native American events as well as a powwow in the afternoon.

Lodge Competitions- Activities and competitions will occur for the most part on Saturday afternoon.

Ceremonies Competitions- Lodges are invited to bring their ceremony teams to compete and to gather ideas from one another.

Trainings- This year's lineup of trainings cover a wide range of general Order of the Arrow knowledge, chapter management, and lodge management. Courses will vary in previous knowledge so that there will be something useful to all participants.

Uniforming- The required uniforming for all Arrowmen is "field dress" with OA sash. This policy may be relaxed during the event and will be announced.
